

## **DAAD Prize 2020 for Outstanding Achievements of International Students**

Thousands of international students are enrolled at German universities and technical colleges. They enrich the university community both culturally and academically. This year, in order to honour these circumstances, the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) has once again provided funds to the universities in order to award the DAAD Prize to outstanding international students.

At the Humboldt-Universität, the prize can be awarded in the amount of

**1,000 Euro**

International students with exceptional academic achievements and remarkable social – especially intercultural – commitment can be recognised through this prize. The students should be near the end of their Bachelor's degree programme or in their Master's degree course, provided that achievements acquired at the HU can already be clearly identified and evaluated or certified. Additionally, recent graduates and doctoral candidates are welcome to apply. The applicants should not already have a scholarship from a German organisation.

Applicants must submit an outstanding piece of **academic work** (seminar paper, term paper, thesis or the like; no dissertations) as well as **further application documents:**

- Letter of application and motivation according to the call for applications
- Curriculum vitae in tabular form
- Current enrolment certificate (please do not submit the matriculation certificate)
- Current transcripts (from AGNES); if applicable, transcripts from earlier studies
- Two appraisals from university lecturers/professors (see form online)
- References or other relevant documents according to the call for applications (e.g. collaboration in organisations, intercultural commitments or volunteering at the applicant's university institute or elsewhere)
