***IBAN (International Bank Account Number)** codes have been implemented since January 2002 in the following European countries to facilitate international bank transfers:

Andorra, Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Spain Sweden, Switzerland, United Kingdom.

The code is compulsory if your country has implemented this system. Without these codes your payment will not be processed,

The IBAN code begins with two letters identifying the country and is followed by 15-25 characters.

(ex. GB12 BARC 1234 5678 9123 45). If you do not have this code your bank will be able to provide it.

****SWIFT (Society for Worldwide Interbank Financial Telecommunications) or BIC code** consists of 8 characters. The letters correspond to the bank name, the country, and the bank division (ex. PSTBLNL21 for a Postbank branch in the Netherlands)
