DAAD STIBET scholarships for particularly socially engaged international PhD candidates

These Scholarships, funded by DAAD through subsidies from the German ministry of foreign affairs, will be awarded to particularly socially engaged doctoral candidates of the Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin (HU) with an outstanding commitment within the international context.

Amount of scholarship

The amount granted depends on individual financial needs and the scope of engagement in an international context. Generally, the allowance amounts to \in 600 per month and are usually awarded for **up to max.** 5 months.

Requirements

- ✓ Enrolment as an international PhD candidate at the HU
- ✓ Outstanding social engagement within an international context

- √ Good performance in your doctoral studies programme
- ✓ Non-German citizenship and qualification for university entrance (Bildungsausländer)

Application

Deadlines: 28 February/31.May/31.August 2021. Generally, the allowance amounts to € 600 per month.

- ✓ Certificate of enrolment (indicating current semester)
- ✓ Letter of motivation, detailing your current or intended voluntary commitment within an international context (max. two pages)

- √ Signed CV (max. two pages)
- ✓ Letter of recommendation about your volunteer involvement
- ✓ Proof of income (employment and other scholarships)

Please note that if you work part time, any gross salary above 1650 Euro/month including your stipend will reduce the monthly scholarship. Please be also aware that certain scholarship programmes are exclusive and that you might not be allowed to receive several scholarships at a time.

Applications can be submitted in English or German.
