Become a Circle U. Student Fellow at Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin!

Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin is inviting applications for three student fellowships within the European University Alliance Circle U., offering a unique opportunity to work on interdisciplinary research and activities across global themes. The positions are open to both advanced Bachelor's (from 3rd semester) and Master's students, with the possibility of scientific development and involvement in the academic community.

We offer 3 Student Fellowship Positions for

a) Fellows for the Knowledge Hub Climate

Work directly with the Knowledge Hub Climate, contributing to research and initiatives focused on climate action and sustainability.

b) Cross-Hub Fellows

Work across all four Circle U. Knowledge Hubs: Artificial Intelligence, Democracy, Global Health, and Climate, assisting with activities that bridge the interdisciplinary topics and foster collaboration between hubs.

Conditions & Application Process

Key responsibilities

- Assist with research, content creation, and preparation for publications, events, and activities related to the four Circle U. Knowledge Hubs (with a specific focus on the Climate Hub for one fellow).
- Support event planning and organization, including public events, summer schools, discussion forums, PhD workshops, and open conversations.
- Collaborate with and support Circle U. Student Ambassadors and partner institutions.
- Engage in networking and communication with student representatives, student initiatives, and thematic stakeholders, such as partner organizations, sustainability offices, climate management teams, etc.
- Research grants and funding opportunities, and monitor available calls for proposals to support relevant initiatives.

Requirements

- Proficiency in English (C1 level).
- Ideally, knowledge of a second language of a Circle U. partner
- Advanced BA students (3rd semester and beyond) or MA students.
- Experience in an association, student representation, or similar roles is considered an advantage.













What We Offer

- Workload: at average 30 hours per month.
- Stipend: A competitive monthly stipend of 500 EUR will be provided for each fellowship.
- Academic Development: An excellent opportunity for personal and professional growth, contributing to interdisciplinary projects and gaining exposure to international networks and collaborations.
- **Duration:** Positions are to commence by **1 June 2025** and will run up to **31 December 2025** with the possibility of extension in 2026.
